
Introduction

Magento 2 Custom Price extension facilitates store owners in getting the custom price of the product from the customer base. It's useful when the store owner can't fix the product price of his store. From the admin end, the store owner can fix the price according to their desire which will be the lowest in the ideal case, which will not be visible to the customer.

Installation Steps

1. Upload Extension Folder

- Get an extension from our extension store or marketplace.
- Unzip the extension and upload the folder structure to your store root directory like the following image



2. Install and Activate the Module

Login to your SSH server and go to your root directory of Magento2 installation. Enter the following commands via SSH using Putty or others.

php bin/magento setup:upgrade

following is the example:

```
:/var/www/html$ php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```



Deactivation Steps

1. Deactivate using SSH (Command Line)

Login to your SSH server and go to your root directory of Magento2 installation. Enter the following commands via SSH using Putty or others.

```
php bin/magento module:disable Codedecorator_Core
```

```
php bin/magento module:disable Codedecorator_Customprice
```

2. Flush the cache

You can flush the cache from the admin or you can do it using the following command in SSH login.

```
php bin/magento cache:clean
```

Remove Module Steps

1. Deactivate using SSH (Command Line)

Login to your SSH server and go to your root directory of Magento2 installation. Enter the following commands via SSH using Putty or others.

```
php bin/magento module:disable Codedecorator_Core
```


```
php bin/magento module:disable Codedecorator_Customprice
```

2. Remove the module directory

Remove the module directory using the FTP manager and delete the director available on the following directory path

<Magento2 Root Director>/app/code/Codedecorator/ It should look like the following





3. Flush the cache

You can flush the cache from the admin or you can do it using the following command in SSH login.

```
php bin/magento cache:clean
```
