Please be sure to carefully read through the information below so you are well prepared prior to arriving on site.

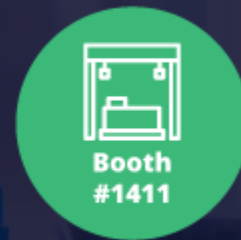
Before you make your way to Washington, DC be sure to pack the following:
